Fabico professor is elected president for the International Society for Knowledge Organization

Thiago Henrique Bragato Barros will be the first Brazilian to occupy the presidency of the entity. Term of office is two years

The professor of the Department of Information Sciences, Faculty of Library and Communication, Thiago Henrique Bragato Barros is the President-elect for the [International Society for Knowledge Organization \(ISKO\)](#). The professor will take office as President in 2022 and will run ISKO until 2024 – it is the first time that a Brazilian holds this position.

ISKO is an interdisciplinary society that brings together about 600 members from different countries, who work in areas such as information science, philosophy, linguistics and computer science. The association encourages research and the development of knowledge organization systems, promoting scientific events and publications in the area.

According to the professor, who is researching precisely in the area of knowledge organization, the opportunity to occupy the position as President of ISKO is an important step towards the internationalization of the studies that have been carried out in Brazil on the subject. "For UFRGS, it also represents the recognition of the work that has been developed in the area," adds the researcher.
